Perhaps, more than any other aircraft, the Tiger Moth was the aircraft that most Canadian aces flew. It was a simple, rugged, and reliable aircraft that was easy to fly and maintain. It was the perfect aircraft for a pilot who wanted to learn the basics of flying and to gain experience in a variety of flying conditions. The Tiger Moth was also a very popular aircraft among the general public, and it was often used for training and recreation. It was a true Canadian icon, and it played a significant role in the development of Canadian aviation.

All Tiger Moths were built by the early fighter pilots, often under very tight and stressful conditions. They were engaged in a race against time, with a limited budget and a shortage of resources. Despite these challenges, they managed to produce a large number of aircraft that were of high quality and reliability. This was a testament to the skill and determination of the Canadian fighter pilots, and it was a key factor in their success during the war.
